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## Charity Care

- Patients without health insurance should first apply to a hospital's charity care program. To enroll, you must bring as many of the following as possible to your appointment:
  - **Identification**
    - *Ex: driver's license, state/county ID, Social Security Card, birth certificate*
  - **Proof of NJ Residency**
    - *Ex: utility bill, phone bill, valid driver's license*
  - **Asset Information**
    - *Ex: bank statement for checking/savings account*
  - **Reason to enroll in charity care**
    - *Prescription for tests (like blood test, Ultrasound, Xray), emergency room bill*
    - *At minimum, you should get a prescription for a CBC blood test from your primary doctor to make sure you have a reason to get into charity care*
- For charity care, you can go to:

  - Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital (Hamilton)
    - Phone: 609-586-7900
- You will first schedule a "screening meeting" where a representative from the charity care will check all your documents and pass you for charity care.
- St. Francis and Capital Health charity care usually enrolls patients faster than Robert Wood Johnson. BUT, some Medina doctors only work through Robert Wood Johnson, so you must register there
- If you are not sure which hospital charity care to go to, please call our patient navigator, Judith Hamilton, as soon as possible at 609-235-8200
- For a general primary visit, not for charity care, you can go to:

- Please note: Charity Care usually expires after one year. You must reapply and go through a screening process once it expires.
